Answer: A towel.

Answer: A needle.

Answer: Five minutes.

Answer: A teapot.

Q16. A plane crashes on the border of two countries. Where do they bury survivors?

Answer: You don't bury survivors.

Q17. What goes up but never comes down?

Answer: Your age.

Q18. I speak without a mouth and hear without ears. What am I?

Answer: An echo.

Q19. Which weighs more: a pound of feathers or a pound of bricks?

Answer: They weigh the same.

Answer: A comb.
