Arrange the words in a meaningful order:

3. Job
4. Application

- A. 2, 4, 1, 3
B. 4, 2, 1, 3
C. 2, 1, 4, 3
D. 4, 1, 2, 3

Answer: A. 2, 4, 1, 3

Explanation: Resume → Application → Interview → Job

Q2. Analogy

Clock : Time :: Thermometer : ?

- A. Heat
- B. Temperature
- C. Weather
- D. Pressure

Answer: B. Temperature

Explanation: A clock measures time, a thermometer measures temperature.

Q3. Classification

Choose the odd one out:

- A. Tiger
- B. Lion
- C. Leopard
- D. Goat

Answer: D. Goat

Explanation: Others are carnivores; goat is a herbivore.

Q4. Series completion

Complete the series:

A, C, F, J, O, ?

- A. T
- B. U
- C. V
- D. W

Answer: B. U

Explanation: Pattern increases by +2, +3, +4, +5 → next +6 → U

Q5. Verification of truth

Statement:

All engineers are graduates. Some graduates are managers.

Conclusion:

Some managers are engineers.

- A. True
- B. False
- C. Cannot Say

Answer: C. Cannot Say

Explanation: No direct link between managers and engineers.

Q6. Direction sense

Ravi walks 10 meters north, then 5 meters east, then 10 meters south. Where is he now relative to the starting point?

- A. 5 meters east
- B. 5 meters west
- C. 10 meters east
- D. Same position

Answer: A. 5 meters east

Explanation: He cancels north-south movement and remains 5 meters east.

Q7. Syllogism

Statements:

All pens are books.
All books are tables.

Conclusion:

All pens are tables.

- A. True
- B. False
- C. Cannot Say

Answer: A. True

Explanation: Pens → Books → Tables, so the conclusion follows.

Q8. Word formation

Choose the correct word formed by adding a prefix to “Legal”

- A. Illegal
- B. Unlegal
- C. Legalness
- D. Legally

Answer: A. Illegal

Explanation: Prefix “il-” forms the correct word.

Q9. Data sufficiency**Question:**

Is $x > y$?

Statements:

1. $x = 10$

2. $y = 5$

- A. Only statement 1 is sufficient
- B. Only statement 2 is sufficient
- C. Both together are sufficient
- D. Insufficient

Answer: C. Both together are sufficient

Explanation: We need both values to compare x and y .

Q10. Seating arrangement (basic)

Five people A, B, C, D and E are sitting in a row. A is to the left of B. C is to the right of B. Who is in the middle?

- A. A
- B. B
- C. C
- D. Cannot be determined

Answer: D. Cannot be determined

Explanation: Exact positions are not fully defined.

- B. 2, 4, 1, 3
- C. 4, 1, 2, 3

Answer: A. 4, 2, 1, 3

Explanation: Letters form words, words form sentences, and sentences form paragraphs.

Q12. Analogy

Eye : See :: Ear : ?

- A. Speak
- B. Hear
- C. Smell
- D. Touch

Answer: B. Hear

Explanation: The eye is used to see, and the ear is used to hear.

Q13. Classification

Choose the odd one out:

- A. Copper
- B. Iron
- C. Gold
- D. Plastic

Answer: D. Plastic

Explanation: Others are metals; plastic is not.

Q14. Series completion

Complete the series:

2, 6, 7, 21, 22, ?

- A. 44
- B. 66
- C. 46
- D. 48

Answer: B. 66

Explanation: Pattern alternates $\times 3$ and $+1 \rightarrow 22 \times 3 = 66$

Q15. Verification of truth

Statement:

Some teachers are writers. All writers are readers.

Conclusion:

Some teachers are readers.

- A. True
- B. False
- C. Cannot Say

Answer: A. True

Explanation: Teachers \rightarrow Writers \rightarrow Readers, so some teachers are readers.

Q16. Direction sense

Aman walks 5 meters south, then 10 meters east, then 5 meters north.
Where is he now?

- A. 10 meters east
- B. 5 meters west
- C. Same position
- D. 10 meters west

Answer: A. 10 meters east

Explanation: South and north cancel out, leaving 10 meters east.

Q17. Syllogism

Statements:

All fruits are healthy.
Some healthy things are expensive.

Conclusion:

Some fruits are expensive.

- A. True
- B. False
- C. Cannot Say

Answer: C. Cannot Say

Explanation: No direct link between fruits and expensive items.

Q18. Word formation

Choose the correct word formed by adding a suffix to "Care"

- A. Careful
- B. Carely

- D. Cared

Answer: A. Careful

Explanation: Adding suffix “-ful” forms the correct word.

Q19. Data sufficiency

Question:

Is x an even number?

Statements:

1. x is divisible by 2
2. $x = 9$

- A. Only statement 1 is sufficient
- B. Only statement 2 is sufficient
- C. Both together are sufficient
- D. Insufficient

Answer: A. Only statement 1 is sufficient

Explanation: Divisible by 2 confirms even; statement 2 contradicts.

Q20. Seating arrangement

Six people sit in a row. A is not at either end. B is to the immediate right of A. Who is at the ends?

Answer: B. Cannot be determined

Explanation: Not enough information to identify both ends.

Explanation: A city is part of a state, a state is part of a country, and a country is part of a continent.

Q22. Analogy

Bird : Nest :: Bee : ?

- A. Hole
- B. Hive
- C. Forest
- D. Cage

Answer: B. Hive

Explanation: A bird lives in a nest, while a bee lives in a hive.

Q23. Classification

Choose the odd one out:

- A. Wheat
- B. Rice
- C. Barley
- D. Cotton

Answer: D. Cotton

Explanation: Wheat, rice and barley are food grains, while cotton is a fibre crop.

Q24. Series completion

Complete the series:

3, 9, 27, 81, ?

- A. 108
- B. 162
- C. 243
- D. 324

Answer: C. 243

Explanation: Each number is multiplied by 3.

Q25. Verification of truth

Statement:

All laptops are electronic devices. Some electronic devices are expensive.

Conclusion:

Some laptops are expensive.

- A. True
- B. False
- C. Cannot Say

Answer: C. Cannot Say

Explanation: We know laptops are electronic devices, but we do not know whether any of the expensive electronic devices are laptops.

Q26. Direction sense

Priya walks 8 meters west, then 6 meters north, then 8 meters east. Where is she now from the starting point?

- A. 6 meters north
- B. 6 meters south
- C. 8 meters east
- D. Same position

Answer: A. 6 meters north

Explanation: West and east movements cancel each other out, so she is 6 meters north of the starting point.

Q27. Syllogism

Statements:

All roses are flowers.

All flowers are plants.

Conclusion:

All roses are plants.

A. True

B. False

C. Cannot Say

Answer: A. True

Explanation: Since all roses are flowers and all flowers are plants, all roses are plants.

Q28. Word formation

Choose the correct word formed by adding a prefix to “Regular”

A. Irregular

B. Unregular

C. Deregular

D. Regularly

Answer: A. Irregular

Explanation: Adding the prefix “ir-” forms the correct word “Irregular”.

Q29. Data sufficiency**Question:**

Is x less than 20?

Statements:

1. $x = 18$
2. x is an even number

- A. Only statement 1 is sufficient
- B. Only statement 2 is sufficient
- C. Both together are sufficient
- D. Insufficient

Answer: A. Only statement 1 is sufficient

Explanation: Statement 1 directly tells us that x is 18, which is less than 20. Statement 2 alone is not enough.

Q30. Seating arrangement

Seven people are sitting in a row. P is in the middle. Q is immediately to the left of P. R is immediately to the right of P. Who is sitting in the middle?

- A. Q
- B. P
- C. R
- D. Cannot be determined

Answer: B. P

Explanation: The question directly states that P is in the middle.
